



Using Gift Aid means that for every pound you give, we get an extra 28 pence from the Inland Revenue. This means that subscriptions of £15 can be turned into £19.20 just so long as they are made through Gift Aid, and it doesn't cost you a thing.

Subject to a few simple rules, you can give any amount of money, large or small, regular or one-off and we can reclaim the tax, you can even backdate your declaration to cover all donations made since 6 April 2000, just complete the simple declaration printed below and return it to us.

Notes

1. You must pay an amount of UK income and/or capital gains tax at least equal to the tax we will reclaim on your subscription and/or donation in the tax year (£4.20 if you pay £15 subscription).
2. You can cancel this declaration at any time by notifying us by writing to the Membership Secretary, PO Box 62, Camborne TR14 7ZN.
3. If in the future your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income and capital gains equal to the tax that we reclaim, you must let us know.
4. If you pay tax at the higher rate you can claim further tax relief in your Self-Assessment tax return.
5. If you want further information about Gift Aid ask your local tax office for leaflet IR65.
